The Vision Statement is a narrower, future-oriented declaration of the organization's purpose and aspirations. Thus, the purpose of a Vision Statement for our Tribal Education Agency is to explicitly state the agreed-upon purpose which drives decisions. The Vision Statement acts as a declaration and a guide to internal decision-making.

A Mission Statement is a public declaration used to describe the founding purpose, values, and major organizational commitments. Mission statements are the "how-to" statements or action plans that help school systems achieve their vision. They prompt change and growth.

Together, a mission and vision statements guide strategy development, help communicate the organization's purpose to stakeholders, and inform the goals and objectives set to determine whether the strategy is on track.

Sample Vision Statement #1:

Preparing each student to succeed through resiliency in a rapidly changing world.

Sample Vision Statement #2:

Every student ready for college, career, and life.

Sample Mission Statement #1:

The Blue Lake Rancheria Tribal Education Agency utilizes a standards-based education that addresses individual differences and learning styles. We empower students to take ownership and responsibility for their present and future learning by developing their academic, interpersonal, intrapersonal, and technological skills. We value:

- Learning – supporting a learning environment that continuously motivates all individuals to excel;
- Relationships – creating and maintaining meaningful relationships among students, families, teachers, staff, and community partners;
- Integrity – conducting ourselves with honesty and responsibility;
- Accountability – demonstrating a personal and institutional accountability for student learning, ethical conduct, and adherence to mandates, policies, and procedures;
- Innovation – challenging ourselves to create unique ideas and innovative solutions in a technology rich environment;
- Respect – promoting a school community that appreciates the values of students, families, colleagues, and cultures;
