**Human Trafficking Seminar: The State of Human Trafficking in California** - This Instructor Led-Virtual Training (VILT) 8-hour course conducted over two days provides a review of critical or developing issues for law enforcement and victim service personnel, in addition to updates on new emerging tactics, techniques and protocols in the fight against human trafficking.
