



**ORDINANCE NO. 18-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BUSINESS COUNCIL OF THE BLUE LAKE RANCHERIA PROHIBITING THE INTENTIONAL TAMPERING WITH A FIRE ALARM AND ESTABLISHING THE PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION.**

The Business Council of the Blue Lake Rancheria (“Business Council”) hereby ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Blue Lake Rancheria Law & Order Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Chapter 7. VIOLATIONS AGAINST HEALTH AND SAFETY**

**Section 7.06 Tampering with a Fire Alarm**

(A) A person commits tampering with a fire alarm when he or she willfully tampers with, molests, injures, impairs the function of, or breaks any fire protection equipment, smoke alarm, fire protection installation, fire alarm apparatus, wire, or signal.

The Detailed Judgment Schedule in Section 7.06 is hereby amended to add:

Section 7.06 Class B Violation..... \$500

**SECTION 2. Severability.** If any court of competent jurisdiction determines that any of the provisions of this ordinance are invalid, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. The Business Council declares that it would have enacted each of the sections of this ordinance separately and, to that end, declares that each of the provisions of this ordinance is severable.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** The provisions of this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon their passage.
