Activities planned will be engaging, fun, and primarily handson. Student learning will be supported by regular check-ins, rest times/breaks, and activity tracks based on student interests. An optional light breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided. Camp will be held in Blue Lake at Blue Lake Rancheria during the day (no overnight/camping) and is supported by local responder partners such as Humboldt County CERT Coalition, Humboldt County Office of Emergency Services, local fire and EMS, and more. DIRECTIONS: The Blue Lake Rancheria RTIC is located in Humboldt County, California on State Route 299 east. Take the Blue Lake Exit (Exit 5) onto Blue Lake Blvd. Turn right at the round-about and follow Chartin Road straight into the Blue Lake Rancheria.

Sapphire Palace Event Center: 777 Casino Way. Enter main entrance of Blue Lake Rancheria and stay to the right. Use casino general parking area. After you go through the main casino door, go left. The entrance to the Sapphire Palace is to the right of the Redwood Rewards Club.

Tribal Government Office: 1 Aiyekwee Loop. Enter main entrance Blue Lake Rancheria. Take Batwot Drive past gas station and continue through to Rancheria Road. Turn right at Rancheria Road through the open chain link gate. Straight ahead to the Tribal Gov't Office is on the right, near fire department (blue metal building). Entrance on north side of building where electric car chargers are.
